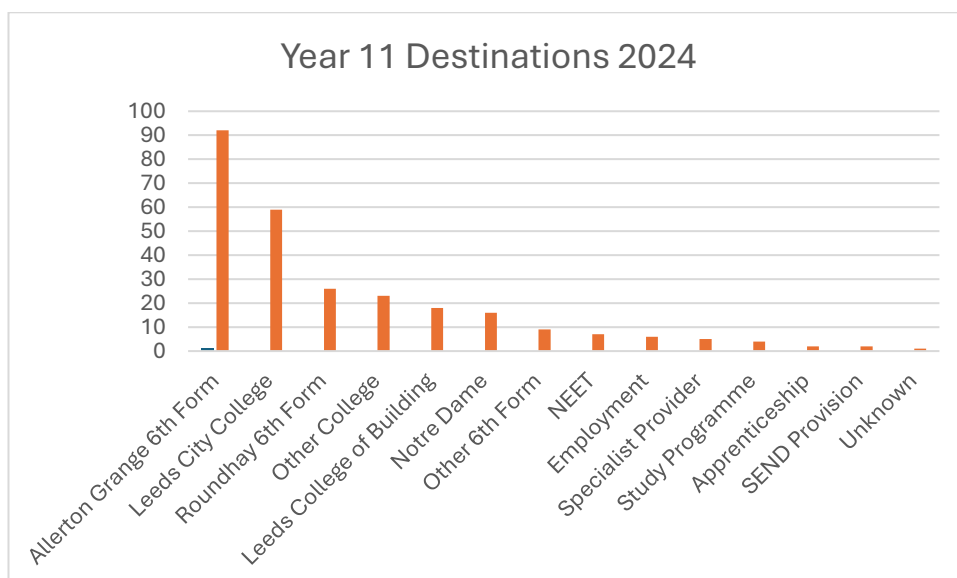


Destination Data 2024 - Year 11 Leavers 2024

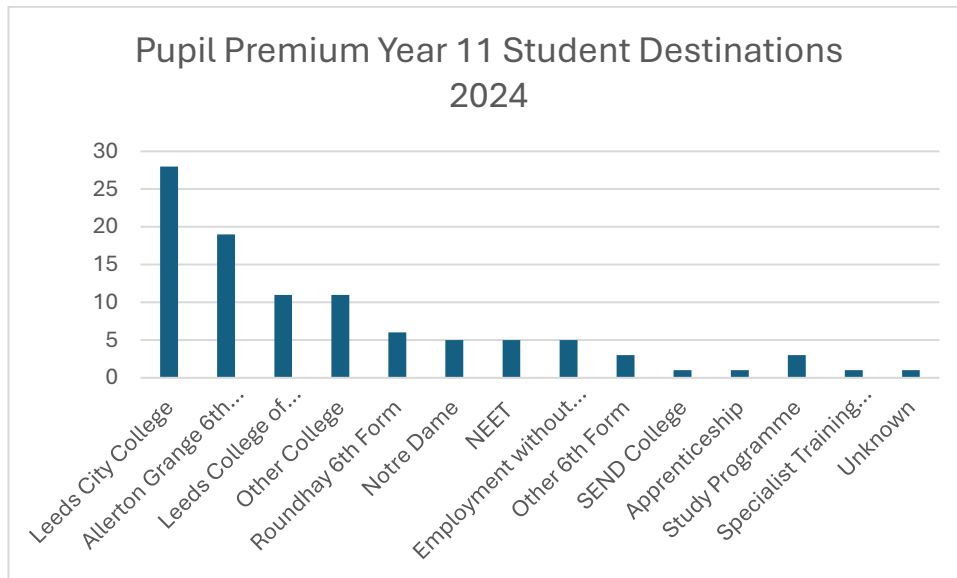

Observations from 2024 results and destinations

- 5 students choosing to re-sit GCSE's at Leeds City College
- Significant increase in number of students enrolled at Leeds College of Building (3 trips ran here in October 2023 which likely impacted the number).
- More students working without training (family businesses).
- NEET figures impacted by very late data from Leeds City Council (sent to us in December).
- Increase number of students studying T Levels.
- Increase number of students attending UTC (presentation from UTC to Y11 was introduced last academic year).
- Unknown student has potentially returned to home country.
- Increase in range of colleges and specialist colleges/provisions attended Post-16 on previous years, potentially linked to increased communications with parents/carers to highlight open events for a wide range of colleges.
- 2.6% NEET remains well below the local authority and national average.
