



Observations from 2024 results and destinations

- More students are choosing to re-sit exams, all are students who had applied and still hope to go to university.
- All Gap year students are working either part time, full time or in a volunteering role.
- More clearing places were available for those who narrowly missed out on grades, particularly in healthcare courses.
- Universities wanted to interview for clearing courses, rather than giving immediate offers.
- All apprenticeships have been found after results day, students did not receive apprenticeship offers before results day (although most had not applied).
- SEND and disadvantaged destination data is excellent.




