The A Level Results Day is on Thursday 15 August 2024. I would like to thank you for your support throughout the examination period, and I look forward to celebrating the results with your child on the day.

Students may collect their results from school between **8.00am until 12.00pm**. They should enter the building via the student entrance and collect their results from the main hall. There will be a careers adviser present on the day for those students who wish to receive further information following their results.

If you are unable to attend results day, you can either:

- 1. Email in advance to exams@allertongrange.com and request to have results emailed to you. Results will be emailed out to students, via their school email address, by 12.00pm.
- 2. Nominate a family member to collect results on the student's behalf. The nominated person will need to attend school with a signed letter from the student, authorising that person to collect the results on their behalf. The nominated person must bring photo ID.
- 3. It will not be possible for results to be given over the phone.

If you do not receive the email on the day, please email exams@allertongrange.com.

For those students applying to higher education, they will be able to access their university offers on the morning of Thursday 15 August Via UCAS. This will inform them if they have been accepted, subject to meeting their offer entry requirements, for either their first or second choice universities. In the event that they do not meet the entry requirements, they may choose to enter the clearing process. Students must initiate this process as soon as possible and I recommend they come to school, at the earliest opportunity, so the Sixth Form team can support them with this.
