Re Y10 Sixth Form Taster Day – Wednesday 26 June 2024

I am writing to inform you that all students in Year 10 will be taking part in our Sixth Form Taster Day on Wednesday 26 June 2024. This is an exciting opportunity for our students to experience a day in the life of Allerton Grange Sixth Form and to support them in making choices about their education opportunities post 16.

Allerton Grange has an inclusive and academic Sixth Form with a broad range of courses and enrichment to support students in their transition to higher education and higher level apprenticeships. The Taster Day will allow students to experience five A level lessons of their choosing. They will also hear from our current student leadership group about life in the Sixth Form and the many opportunities that we are able to provide young people.

During the final session of the day, students will attend an enrichment fair in the Sixth Form building. They will be able to speak to our current Sixth Formers as well as enquire about all of the supra-curricular and extra-curricular opportunities that are available to strengthen their applications and support their personal development. This includes access to a range of additional courses such as the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) or discovering the wide range of activities offered in our form time enrichment programme such as Core Maths and learning British Sign Language.

Students are not expected to wear their school uniform for the day but should be dressed appropriately following the Sixth Form dress code outlined below:
