Parents/Carers - We will:

- Ensure that my child attends school every day, on time and fully equipped.
- Inform the school using Class Charts, if my child is unwell and/or unable to attend school.
- Fully support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and uniform.
- Ensure that my child is organised for learning by regularly checking and renewing their equipment.
- Fully support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- Support my child to participate in enrichment opportunities including educational trips and visits
- Attend consultation evenings and information evenings for my child.
- Support and encourage my child to behave and communicate in ways that demonstrates the AGS virtues.
- Promote a love of reading through our literacy programme.
- Engage with the ClassCharts parent communication app to check your child's progress and their homework on a weekly basis.
- Always respectfully communicate with all members of the school community.
- Have a reflective conversation with my child after each reporting cycle, to nurture my child's ability to self-reflect.
- To support my child by providing routines and habits at home, which will maximise their ability to engage with their learning.

Pupils - I will:

- Demonstrate respect for all staff and fellow pupils and the school environment, through the way that I respond verbally and non-verbally to all members of our school community.
- Show kindness and support to peers and staff by using positive language, celebrating everyone's success and encouraging everyone to achieve and behave their best each day.
- Embrace the AGS virtues by demonstrating them through my words and actions.
- Engage in lessons and strive to meet the STAR expectations every lesson.
- Demonstrating through the way that I transition in communal spaces that I respect and care for everyone by walking in a calm, and quiet manner.

- Be organised to learn by having my planner, book and equipment out at the start of every lesson, so that the lesson can promptly start, and all pupils' learning is not paused to hand out equipment.
- Ensure that I am on time to every lesson, so that I can maximise my learning and to ensure that I do not disrupt other pupil's learning.
- Nurture my physical and mental health and wellbeing by using positive daily habits such as minimising screen time on an evening. I will also seek support from the staff at school if I face difficulties.
- Positively represent the school within school, in and outside of school.
- Check the ClassCharts app every day.

School - We will:

- Provide a quality first education through full access to our KLAS curriculum, that is designed to support the academic and personal development of all pupils.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum supported by meaningful homework.
- Ensure high expectations and a calm climate for learning for every pupil through our positive discipline policy and the STAR policy.
- Use effective methods of teaching based on evidence-based research.
- Promote a love of learning and reading through our literacy programme.
- Provide a safe environment to learn through ensuring that we follow our safeguarding policies and more generally that all adults in school create a safe climate through their choice of words and actions.
- Be committed to offering all pupils a wide range of enrichment activities and trips to enhance their learning and personal development.
- Clearly communicate and model expected positive behaviours to pupils, as well as the consequences if pupils do not follow the expectations.
- Report on your child's progress twice each academic year.
- Provide opportunities for parents to engage with the school through ClassCharts and Parents' information evenings.
- Contact parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality, equipment, uniform or behaviour.
- Use Class Charts as a tool to communicate the positive and negative behavioural choices that your child makes.
- Recognise, reward and praise our students for their personal progress and achievements
- Provide an annual consultation evening where parents can discuss their child's academic progress.
- Keep parents informed about the school through regular newsletters, the website and notices about special events.

- Encourage parental access to governors and staff as appropriate.
- Respond to parental concerns in a respectful and timely manner.
- Offer parents the opportunity to enter an Intervention Contract to support them in addressing attendance/behavioural issues.
- Develop a partnership of governors, school, parent(s), and child all working together to provide the best education for your child.
